My Prophet is Muhammad




What is your religion?

My religion is Islam.


Who is Your Lord?

My Lord is Allah, the One, the Only One, begets not nor is He begotten, the Eternal, the Absolute. There is none like unto Him. There is none comparable to Him. He is the One who nurtured me and nurtured all of creation through His favours. And He is the One whom I worship, there being to me no (false) Deity worshipped that is equal to Him.



- Aqeedah is <u>only</u> taken based on proofs:
 - 1. From the Qur'an
 - 2. The authentic Sunnah
 - 3. The consensus ('ijmaa) of the Sahabah
- Our interpretation of the religion comes from the three golden generations:
 - 1. The Sahabah who lived and witnessed the revelation
 - 2. The Tabi'een the students of the Sahabah
 - 3. The Students of the Tabi'een





Who created us?



Allah created me and He created all things. Allah is the only One who creates anything from nothing, He only says 'Be' and it is. Allah is the only One who creates with perfection, without defects and faults, unlike His creation. Nothing exists except that it lives under the care and provisions of Allah.

Why were we created?



- If you commit Shirk, you are not a Muslim anymore.
- All forms of worship must be directed to Allah alone.
- Associating partners with Allah or worshipping other than Allah is Shirk.
- Allah created all of the heavens and the Earth and everything within it.



Where is Allah?

It is proven in the Quran and Sunnah (Prophetic teachings) and by the consensus (Ijmaa') of the Salaf (early generations) that Allah is above His heavens, He rose over His Divine Throne (in a manner befitting His Majesty), and that He is the Exalted, Most High. He is above all things, and there is nothing that is above Him. Allah is not everywhere or in every place.



- Some of the Sahabah used to ask this question to the Messenger of Allah, and he would use this as a criterion in some cases to distinguish a believer from a non-believer. This is an important question.
- Subhana Rabiyyal 'Ala (glory be to Allah, the Most High) is a direct contradiction to those who claim Allah is everywhere.





"I had a slave-girl who used to herd sheep for me. One day I discovered that a wolf had killed one of her sheep, and I'm a man from the children of Adam, I get upset like they get upset, and I slapped her in the face. Then I went to the Prophet who impressed upon me the seriousness of my act.

I said: 'O Messenger of Allah, should I not set her free?'

He said: 'Bring her to me.'

So I brought her to the Messenger of Allah.

He (then) asked her: 'Where is Allah?'


She said (and in one narration, 'while pointing up towards the sky...'): 'He is above the heavens.'






What is Your Religion?

Islam is my religion and I am a Muslim. We submit to Allah's Oneness (Tawheed). Abiding by His laws and always seeking to attain His pleasure through obedience. And never committing Shirk by associating partners with Allah.



- Islam is complete and there are no chnages or alterations. Allah said He has completed His religion and favour, therefore anything which was not a part of Islam during the Prophet's time, will never be a part of it.
- We follow Islam as the Prophet followed it and as the Sahaabah understood it, not our own thoughts and logic. The Sahaabah were the biggest scholars of this religion, they were the students of the Messenger of Allah!
- The greatest blessing we have is being blessed with Islam. We should feel honoured as this is the best nation Allah created, for this we should display eternal gratitude.



There is no Deity worthy of being worshipped, followed or obeyed except Allah alone.

This is regularly incorrectly translated as: "No God but Allah." This is an incorrect statement because there are other things being falsely worshipped as a God besides Allah.




All the Prophets and Messengers called to Laa ilaha illAllah. It is the reason why Allah created life and death.



The Mushrikeen believed in Allah, but remained Mushrikeen because although they believed in Allah, they did not worship Him. They took mediators between themselves and Allah.

Megation and Affirmation

Laa ilaha illallah has two pillars:



Negation of all worship offered to other than Allah.



Affirmation that all worship is due rightfully to Allah alone, who hhas no peer, no partner nor associate.



taghout (Juggernaut) is anything that is worshipped besides Allah, and they are pleased with that worship. As Muslims we denounce and hate taghout as they violate the right of Allah, which is to be worshipped.

A popular example of taghout today are presidents and prime ministers. They make people commit Shirk by voting for them in democratic elections, and make laws that replace and oppose the Shari'ah of Allah.



Verily (the right to) legislation belongs to none but Allah

Our Promise - Allah's Right

The right Allah has upon us is to worship Him alone and to stay away from Shirk. The right we have upon Allah in return (as a mercy and favour from Allah) is to not punish us in return.

The Prophet, peace and blessings be upon him, said: "O Mu'adh, do you know what is the right of Allah upon His servants?"

I said: "Allah and His Messenger know best."

The Prophet said: "To worship Him alone and to associate none in worship with Him. And do you know what is their right upon Him?"

I said: "Allah and His Messenger know best."

The Prophet said: "Not to punish them if they do so."

- The servants having a right over Allah is not comparable to Allah having a right over His creation, because we do not have a choice in the matter and we are in need of it. This is a mercy and favour of Allah upon His creation. We did not make a right of Allah, Allah made a right over Himself!
- Islam is complete and there are no changes or alterations. Allah said He has completed His religion and favour, therefore anything which was not a part of Islam during the Prophet's time, will never be a part of it.

The 5 Pillars of Islam

Islam has five pillars. A pillar is a structure that has to be firm in order for our Deen to be strong, and not to crumble down at the first minor shock. These pillars are the minimum requirement for a Muslim. These pillars are outward physical actions.

Ibn umar reported: the Messenger of Allah, peace and blessings be upon him, said, "Islam is built upon five: to worship Allah and to disbelieve in what is worshiped besides Him, to establish prayer, to give charity, to perform the Hajj pilgrimage to the house, and to fast the month of Ramadan." - Bukhaari



1. testimony of faith:

Declaring that there is no deity worthy of worship except Allah and that Muhammad is His last Prophet and Messenger

2. Establishing the prayer:

Praying our five daily prayers at their fixed times

3. Giving zakaat:

Giving 2.5% of our wealth as charity, yearly

4. Fasting:

the month of Ramadan

5. Performing Hajj:

For those that are able, once in their lifetime




















The Pillars of Imaan

There are six pillars of Imaan, these pillars are beliefs performed inwardly, done by the heart, unlike the pillars of Islam.


Umar ibn al-Khattab reported: The Prophet was asked by Jibreel about Imaan and he said: 'It is to believe in Allah, His angels, His books, His Messengers, the Last Day and to believe in the Divine pre-decreed affairs of good and evil thereof.' - Muslim

Who is Your Prophet?

He is Muhammad, the son of 'Abdullah, the son of 'Abdul-Mutallib bin Hashim. Hashim was from the (the tribe of) Quraysh and Quraysh was from the Arabs. And the Arabs are from the offspring of (Prophet) Isma'eel, son of (Prophet) Ibrahim.




- We have to follow the way of the Messenger by:
 - 1. By obeying what he commanded
 - 2. Believing and being certain about what he informed
 - 3. Staying away from anything which he forbade
 - 4. Worshiping Allah only the way he (the Prophet) taught us to worship Him.

The Sunnah includes:

- 1. The Prophet's sayings
- 2. The Prophet's actions
- 3. The Prophet's tacit approvals



Prophets & Messengers


The First Prophet



A Messenger is one sent to a disbelieving nation, with a (new) law revealed (he comes with a scripture), and he is commanded to convey it.

A Prophet is one who is sent to a believing people with the Shari'ah (law) of the Messenger who came before him, to teach them and judge between them.

the Prophet Muhammad said about people gathering on the Judgement Day, they will go to Nuh and say: "O Nuh, you are the first Messenger sent to people on Earth and Allah has called you a grateful slave..."

In Allah's wisdom, He decreed that Adam should be the father of mankind, and His wisdom, mercy and justice decreed that from among Adam's progeny He should select an elite of Messengers and Prophets. Among those whom He chose and preferred over others were the Messengers of strong will [uloo'l-'Azml. And He chose and favoured above them all their leader, the final Messenger, our Prophet Muhammad ibn 'Abdullah. He is indeed the leader of the sons of Adam. He will carry the banner and will be granted the power of intercession [on the Day of Resurrection]. He is the one who will attain al-maqaam al-mahmood (the Praised Position) in Paradise, which will be given to one person only, and that person will be our Prophet (peace be upon him). Hence Allah took the covenant and pledge from all the Prophets that if Muhammad was sent during the lifetime of any one of them, they would be obliged to follow him, to leave behind what they had brought and follow what Muhammad brought.

THE 5 MIGHTY MESSENGERS














We do not differentiate between the message and call of the Prophets and Messengers, but Allah placed them in different status & levels.

The Call/Dawah

All the Prophets and Messengers came with one and the same message. They came with the same purpose which was to correct the people's corrupted beliefs.

All the Prophets and Messengers said plainly to the people: "O my people, there is no God but Allah, so worship Him and worship Him alone."

We do not differentiate between the Prophets and Messengers in their message, it was a united message - to worship Allah alone without association (Tawheed). They were all sent by Allah to guide the people to the truth. There is no distinction between them in their message.

As for their status and prestige, some exceed over others. First are the Prophets, from them are chosen Messengers, from among them five are chosen as the Mighty Messengers (Uloo'l-'Azm), and from the best amongst all is the greatest man Allah created, the most honourable of all Prophets and Messengers - Muhammad (peace be upon him).




Islam

This is the lowest level of faith, it is the bare minimum to be considered a Muslim. A person who enters Islam is called a Muslim. Islam means to submit to Allah fully in Tawheed and to obey Him, and stay away from Shirk and its people.

Shirk invalidates one's Islam

Islam is incorrectly translated as "peace." Islam contains within it peace and comes with peace but Islam means complete and utter submission to Allah alone.

True Islam is the one who submits to Allah and this Islam is to submit and accept completely what Allah has commanded and revealed.


You need to free yourslef from Shirk and its people. To reject and speak against falsehood. You hate in your heart Shirk and that people are upon it, and do your best to speak against it, and the lowest level of faith is to hate it in your heart, the second is to speak against it and the highest dgeree of faith is to change it with your hand if you're in a position of authority to do so.

You should not sit with the people of Shirk and your association with them should be for Da'wah. In your day to day interactions with them, at the very least you hate their Shirk in your heart.

Smaan

This is the second degree of faith. A person who enters Imaan is called a Mu'min. Every Mu'min is a Muslim. Imaan increases with obedience and good deeds and decreases with disobedience and evil deeds.

The three pillars of Imaan:



All three pillars need to be present within a person for their Imaan to be accepted. One must believe in the heart, display this belief through their words and act upon their beliefs e.g., pray, fast.

Imaan is not only in the heart. This is the belief of the misguided Murji'ah. That's why when you advise people who sin in public, they reply, "My Imaan is in my heart." This is wrong. If Imaan is in the heart, it manifests itself on the tongue and the limbs. That's why we are commanded to judge people by the apparent.

Thsaan


This is the highest degree of faith. A person who enters Ihsaan is called a Muhsin. Every Muhsin is also a Muslim and Mu'min. Ihsaan is to worship Allah as if you can see Him, and if you cannot, know He sees you.





Tawheed ar-Ruboobiyyah

This is to single out Allah by His actions. Affirming that Allah alone is the Creator, He alone is the provider, He alone is the sustainer, He alone is the governor and He alone is the legislator. He alone owns everything and is the one to give life and cause death. This belief is the affirmation of the Oneness of His Lordship.



A lot of people believe in this, but they commit Shirk in the other categories of Tawheed that's why they are Kuffar. For example, the Kuffar of Makkah during the Prophet's time.

Tawheed al-Uloohiyyah


Majority of the people commit Shirk in this category, and this can occur through different ways such as devoting physical acts of worship to other than Allah, giving legislative authority to other than Allah or even saying statements that are exclusively for Allah.





Ibaadah

Ibaadah is a comprehensive noun for everything Allah loves and is pleased with, from speeches and actions that are either hidden or apparent (inward and outward) from the belief of the heart, actions of the limbs and statements of the tongue.





For example, being grateful must be accompanied with all three components of faith that are required in Ibaadah



Gratitude in the heart: believe that this blessings is from Allah. This increases the love in your heart for Allah.



Gratitude on the tongue: praise Allah and thank Allah for the blessings He has given you by your tongue. It is also telling people of which Allah has blessed you with out of appreciation, but not in a boastful manner.



Gratitude upon the limbs: using the blessings that Allah has bestowed upon us to show our gratitude to Allah e.g., Allah blessed you with health, use that health to pray extra, fast, etc.,

Tawheed al-Asmaa Wa Sifaat

This is to single out Allah in His names and attributes. We do not describe Allah or name Allah except by which Allah has named Himself or described Himself or what the Messenger of Allah described Allah with.

We understand the names of Allah without doing the following:



takyeef: Imagining how the names and attributes are using your imagination. Allah is not limited to our imagination.



tamtheel: this is similar to takyeef, it is to make similatude and comparison to Allah with His creation. Comparing Allah to what you know.

For example, Allah's hand cannot be comapred to the hand of His creation - be it human, animal or anything else. Our comprehension and knowledge is very limited.



tahreef: distorting the names and attributes of Allah from the actual meaning in the Arabic language.

For example, if Allah speaks about His hand, do not distort its meaning by saying it avtually means power.



Ta'teel: Negating the names and attributes of Allah. Shaytaan afflicts the heart during these stages. Some do this completely like the Jahmiyyah, and others do it partially like the Asha'irah
